An adventurer to the end, our patron's innovative, adventurous, sublime and appropriate ceremony at Windsor Castle - St George's Chapel, provided the subtlety and sensitivity needed by the world in saying its goodbyes to this remarkable statesperson and true Citizen of Our Globe, who was loved by so many.

In 2000, at the RGS in London Prince Philip called for the Campaign for Adventure at the UK Outdoor-Council conference "Adventure in Society". In its 20 years CfA has changed UK laws through an All Party Parliamentary Group "ARISc", held four consultations on adventure at St George's House, Windsor Castle, and in The Chinese Room, Buckingham Palace, has driven forward the debate on Risk and Enterprise in Society in 12 countries, has identified and celebrated 22 Adventure Champions from diverse UK backgrounds and has challenged the media relentlessly by supporting the understanding of the need for healthy risk-taking in UK life. CfA now finds itself working harder than ever on society's risk-supporting agendas including Summer Camps Trust, the Adventure Licensing review, the CBI Education Agendas and challenging the degree of risk being shown by society in its need to drive changes within COVID19, conservation action and climate change common sense.
